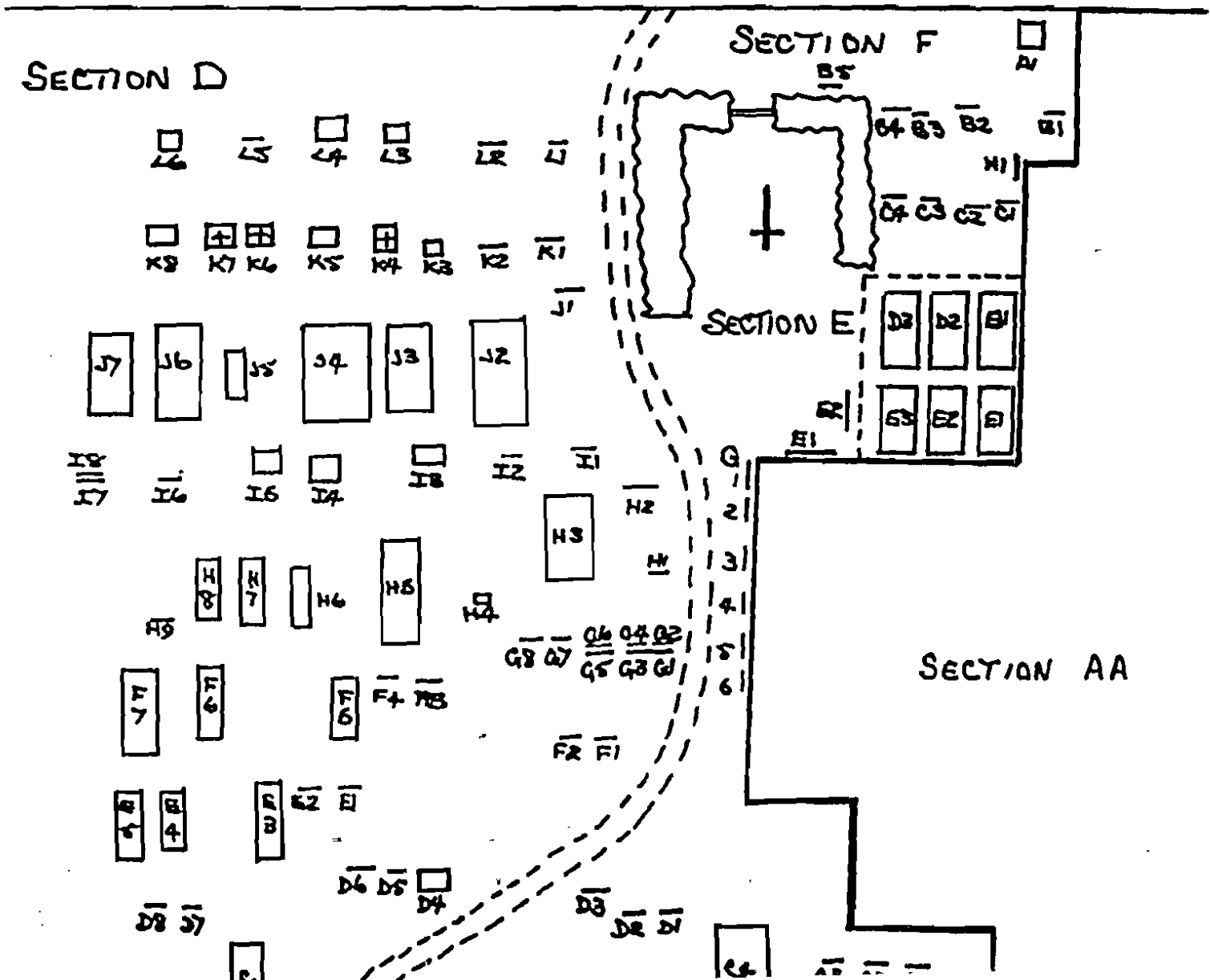

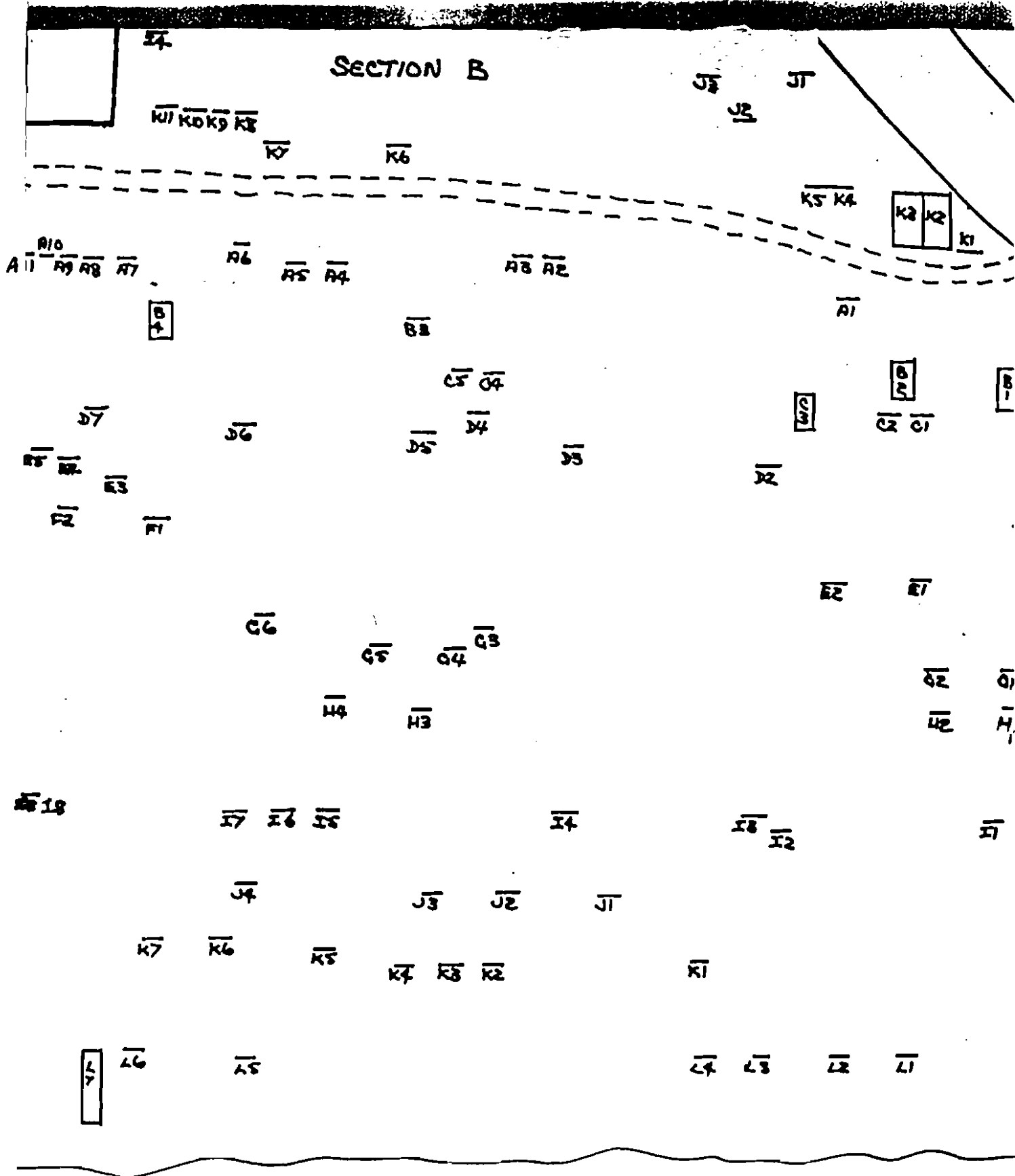
Churchyard Plan shown on 4 sheets commencing with South & West aspects of the Church and continuing clockwise.



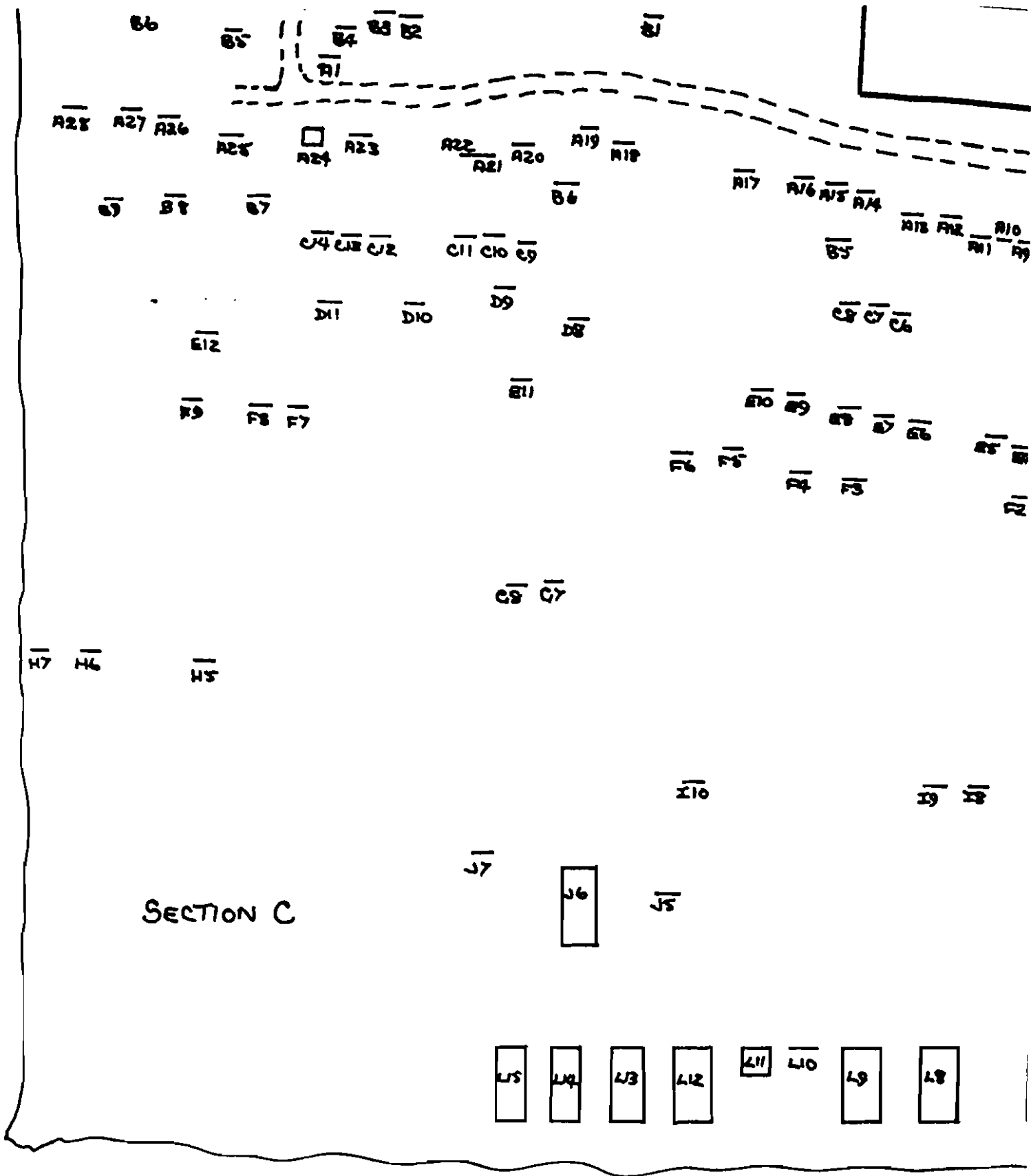
